**Now You See It, Now You Don't: Recovering From Data Loss**

## **ABSTRACT**

Data loss happens every day and at different levels – some disasters will affect a single user or small group, while other types of loss may affect an entire organization. Whether the failure is hardware-related, software-related, the result of human error or due to a natural disaster, the number of data loss events is increasing as consumers and businesses rely on their electronic devices, corporate server structure and document storage volumes. During a data loss event, the primary goal is to restore the original data as soon as possible. Minimizing the impact begins with understanding the levels of data storage, analyzing data loss cases and reviewing the failure points. This session will focus on how data loss happens and will include real examples of data disasters. Attendees will gain a straight-forward understanding of the circumstances that surround data loss disasters, and will be informed as to how to prepare for them.
