100 Year Archive %0Ù0 Where Are We Going and How Will We Get There?

ABSTRACT

Ten years after its first 100 Year Archive Survey, SNIA revisits the requirements for long-term digital information retention in the data center. With the speed of change in the past 10 years, are things the same in the second decade of the 21st century? Can a new 2017 SNIA survey uncover who now is charged with storing, securing, and preserving critical information, and how they will succeed?
