## **ABSTRACT**

Many professional photographers use network attached and direct attached storage (NAS and DAS) locally to coordinate the production activities of their images and videos. The sheer number of files they transfer to their NAS and DAS daily makes it extremely difficult to manage manually, and should an outage occur, their livelihood is threatened. Automatic transfer of files as they are stored or modified, along with the use of AI that identifies the contents of their files, significantly reduces search time, and alleviates the concern associated with relying upon a NAS and DAS exclusively. Using multiple cloud storage accounts is problematic; their files need to be in one secure place. FileShadow was specifically designed to aggregate multiple cloud storage accounts and local NAS and DAS stores together into one secure, searchable vault.
